
Empower Charter School- Policy: Pupil Safety –Human Trafficking Prevention Resources

Background: law (described below)

SB 1104 (Roth-D) - Pupil safety: human trafficking prevention resources

Requires the governing board of a school district and the governing body of a charter school to work with their schools that maintain any of grades 6 to 12, inclusive, to identify the most appropriate methods of informing parents and guardians of pupils in those grades of human trafficking prevention resources and to implement the identified methods in those schools by January 1, 2020.

The Empower Charter School Board of Trustees has identified the most appropriate method(s) to inform parents/guardians of 6th grade students of human trafficking prevention resources:

- On an annual basis, a school communication will be disseminated that includes human trafficking prevention resources.
- The school communication may consist of any of the following:
 - article with information and prevention resources relating to human trafficking
 - websites for parents to learn about human trafficking and prevention resources
- All communications will be available in English and Spanish. This information will be disseminated by one of the following method(s):
 - via regular mail to address on file and/or via email to e-mail address on the file
 - during the annual 6th grade parent meeting
 - other distribution method(s) as determined by the Executive Director
